



## James M. Atkinson Lawsuit Dismissed

REI has no current business relationship, nor will have any business relationship or affiliation with James M. Atkinson or Granite Island Group of Massachusetts.

Mr. James M. Atkinson (Granite Island Group) has made claims on the internet regarding REI (Research Electronics International), and in 2011 Atkinson filed a 474-page suit in the United States District Court of Massachusetts naming more than 100 defendants including REI, six of its employees, and family members. The Court rulings are below.

**On March 14, 2012, the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts ruled in REI's favor on its Motion to Dismiss and for Summary Judgment, thus ending the case against REI.**
